## AHC21020- Cert I in Conservation and Ecosystem Management

Get your career in conservation and land management started with this entry level course that is handson and provides students with the practical knowledge and skills required when maintaining natural places or working in the areas of conservation, parks and gardens or Indigenous land management.

This course will help you develop basic skills and a working knowledge of the conservation industry and is an ideal starting place for individuals who want to work in Indigenous land management, conservation earthworks, lands, parks and wildlife or natural area management.

### **Eligibility**

- Permanent resident of Queensland age 15-65
- No longer at school
- Working less than 20 hours a week

#### **Program length**

The CAEM Traineeship runs 5 days per week (Monday to Friday) for 20 weeks and is a full-time commitment. This program offers paid employment comprising practical work and classroom time.

#### **Fees**

The majority of our participants are eligible for training under the Skilling Queenslanders For Work initiative – which is a no fee training initiative.
